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***Recruiting Message from the SMA** - To meet the demand of our growing Army, we need Professional Noncommissioned Officers to volunteer for vacancies within our Recruiting Force. I am requesting that you talk with NCOs serving in your formations who have previously served on recruiting duty about volunteering to return to USAREC. Former Department of the Army Select Recruiters (DASR) who volunteer to return to USAREC for a 12 month or longer tour are now authorized \$1,500 per month Assignment Incentive Pay (AIP) with an option to pay in \$18,000 lump sum payment annually. This is in addition to Special Duty Assignment Pay (SDAP) of \$300 - \$375 per month, depending on time spent as a recruiter. Eligible volunteers will be offered their top 5 available Recruiting Company assignments.
