WE NEED YOUR HELP! Many AG Soldiers and HR Professionals are lacking identity with the Adjutant General's Corps and the Army HR Community. Many are not aware that the Adjutant General's Corps Regimental Association (AGCRA) even exists.

There are a variety of reasons for HR professionals choosing not to become members of AGCRA, probably the most pressing being, "what does AGCRA offer me?"

There are approximately 39,000 AG / HR Soldiers and Civilian employees assigned to all three components, however, only 3,500, or 9% are AGCRA members. Please consider AGCRA as an old friend that we will reintroduce you to:

1. **Why AGCRA?** When the Army transitioned to a Brigade-centric force, the Army's HR community became more dispersed. Gone are the old PSBs, Personnel Groups and PERSCOMs. Our HR professionals are now more likely in G1 Directorates, Recruiting Brigades / Battalions, Bands, Brigade / Battalion S1 Sections, theater-level HR units, and IMCOM MPDs. The need for a professional AG / HR organization that can reach across all Army components is needed now more than ever. AGCRA continues to serve as the Army's professional AG / HR organization, but we need your help.

2. **The Association's website, AGCRA.com**, has improved. We have 100% functionality and the website allows you to:

- View or post Army HR and AGCRA news, information, and announcements.
- See each separate AGCRA Chapter's web page.
- Contact AGCRA National Executive Council (NEC) members.
- View AGCRA Awards information / criteria.
- View all digital copies of 1775, the AGCRA Professional HR Journal.
- Shop on-line at the Sutler Store, to include purchasing new Association memberships or renewing existing memberships.

3. **"1775"**, the AGCRA's Professional HR Journal.

- Revamped to focus on Army HR professional development. AGCRA continues to solicit "1775" articles from all AG / HR personnel.
- Each 1775 edition is theme oriented.

4. **Awards.** AGCRA recognizes outstanding members with a variety of Association awards.

- Lifetime Achievement Award (Gates Gold second award).
- Horatio Gates Gold Medal.
- Horatio Gates Bronze Medal.
- COL Robert L. Manning Achievement Medal (Chapter President's award) recognizes outstanding AG / HR service to the Army or the Association.
