Users also provided feedback via the IPPS-A Help Center and CRM database, which has enabled our team to implement hundreds of improvements to the system in over 16 updates. The IPPS-A app will be made available to Soldier's in other States when they have entered the window to begin IPPS-A training as part of Release 2. Effective immediately, duty status changes for departure on and return from leave, convalescent leave, permissive TDY, administrative absences, and TDY are mandatory.
